- 1 in 5 families in South Carolina is impacted by hunger

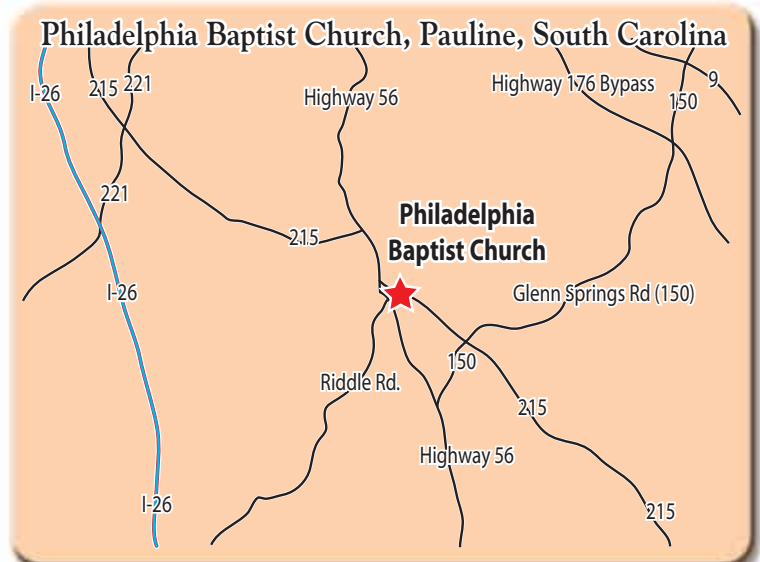
